Communion Statement - The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the Sacrament, are kindly asked first to speak with the pastor. In addition to this being our practice, we do not want our visitors to violate their own conscience or the public confession of faith that is made through their home Church membership. Those not receiving communion are invited to come forward with arms crossed to receive a blessing from the pastor. We thank you for respecting our practice. 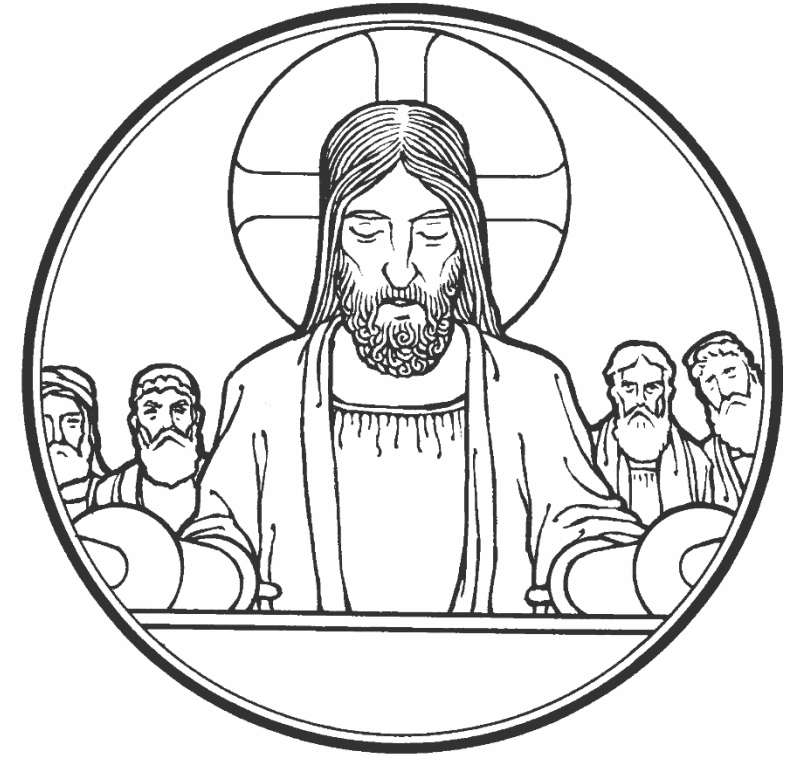
Below you will find a model you can use for your personal or family devotions that focuses you on the readings from the previous Sunday, while also preparing you for what you will hear the following Sunday. In modeling your devotions this way, you and your family can stay united to the church year and reinforce what you hear, sing, and pray every Sunday.

- Mon. 1/27: Read the Old Testament lesson: Nehemiah 8:1-3, 5-6, 8-10 – The Word of God, which Nehemiah read to the people, gives us the joy of the Lord, which is our strength.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 839 – O Christ, Our True and Only Light
Pray the Collect of the Day: Almighty and everlasting God, mercifully look upon our infirmities and stretch forth the hand of Your majesty to heal and defend us; through Jesus Christ, Your Son, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Tues. 1/28: Read the Epistle lesson: 1 Corinthians 12:12-31a – We are the body of Christ, each with different gifts, but united together in Him.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 839 – O Christ, Our True and Only Light
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 1/27)
- Wed. 1/29: Read the Gospel lesson: Luke 4:16-30 – Even though Jesus was rejected in Nazareth, He has still come to proclaim good news to us and the year of the Lord’s favor.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 839 – O Christ, Our True and Only Light
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 1/27)
- Thur. 1/30: Read the Old Testament lesson: 1 Samuel 1:21-28 – As Samuel was presented to the Lord for His service, so too Jesus is presented to the Lord because He has come to serve us.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 519 – In His Temple Now Behold Him
Pray the Collect of the Day: Almighty and ever-living God, as Your only-begotten Son was this day presented in the temple in the substance of our flesh, grant that we may be presented to You with pure and clean hearts; through Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.
- Fri. 1/31: Read the Epistle lesson: Hebrews 2:14-18 – Christ became fully man, in every way, to be with us in our suffering and to save us from sin and death.
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 519 – In His Temple Now Behold Him
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 1/30)
- Sat. 2/1: Read the Gospel lesson: Luke 2:22-32 – As Jesus is presented to the Lord in the temple and to us in the Lord’s Supper, we join with Simeon in confessing, “My eyes have seen your salvation.”
Sing the Hymn of the Day: LSB 519 – In His Temple Now Behold Him
Pray the Collect of the Day: (see 1/30)
