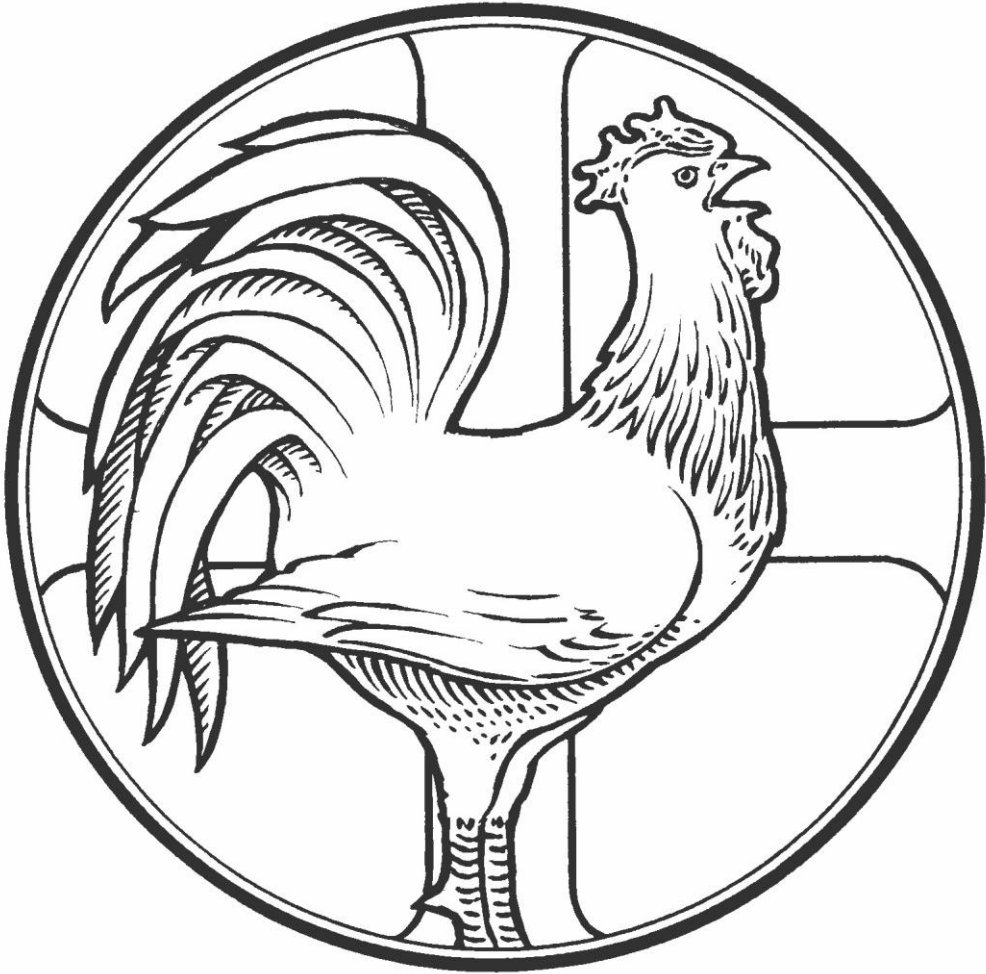

wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
- P** Let me hear joy and gladness;
let the bones that you have broken rejoice.
- C** Hide your face from my sins,
and blot out all my iniquities.
- P** Create in me a clean heart, O God,
and renew a right spirit within me.
- C** Cast me not away from your presence,
and take not your Holy Spirit from me.
- P** Restore to me the joy of your salvation,
and uphold me with a willing spirit.
- C** Then I will teach transgressors your ways,
and sinners will return to you.

and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.
- C** O Lord, open my lips,

- P** Do good to Zion in your good pleasure;
build up the walls of Jerusalem;
- C** then will you delight in right sacrifices,
in burnt offerings and whole burnt offerings;
then bulls will be offered on your altar.

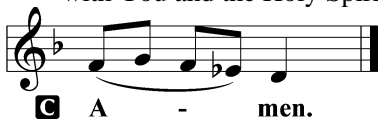
